NOTABLE CASES

Murder and attempted murder

- R v P and another (2023) Defence – junior – two handed allegation of murder of baby
- R v P and others (2023) Defence – junior – three handed allegation of murder awaiting trial
- R v M and others (2022) Defence – junior – nine handed allegation of murder
- R v M (2022) Defence – junior (led by Jenni Dempster QC) – allegation of murder by strangling of the defendant's daughter. This case, described by the Common Serjeant of London as one of the most tragic he had dealt with, concluded with the acceptance of a plea of manslaughter by reason of diminished responsibility – Media Coverage
- R v S (2021) Defence – junior (led by Ali Bajwa QC) – allegation of murder by stabbing of the defendant's ex-partner – Media Coverage
- R v F (2019) Defence – junior (led by Dexter Dias QC) – allegation of murder by stabbing – Media Coverage
- R v I (2018) Defence – junior (led by Ali Bajwa QC) – allegation of murder by shooting – Media Coverage

- R v N (2016) Prosecution – junior alone – allegation of attempted murder by stabbing – [Media Coverage](#)
- R v F (2016) Prosecution – junior alone – allegation of attempted murder – pushing in front of tube train – [Media Coverage](#)
- R v Q (2016) Prosecution – junior alone – 2 handed allegation of attempted murder by stabbing – [Media Coverage](#)

Cases of sexual offending

- R v R (2021) Prosecution – leading junior – allegation of sexual abuse involving multiple victims

Conspiracies to handle stolen goods/rob

- R v V (2020-22) Defence – leading junior – 10 handed allegation of conspiracy to handle stolen goods – ongoing
- R v I (2019) Defence – junior alone – 4 handed allegation of conspiracy to rob (11 cash in transit robberies)

Firearms, gang cases and other serious violence

- R v M (2022) Defence – junior alone – representing an undergraduate and intended medical student on charges of gunpoint kidnap
- R v S (2021) Prosecution – junior alone – allegation of wounding with intent against a sex worker

- R v U (2018-19) Prosecution – leading junior – 11 handed alleged conspiracy to commit GBH
- R v X (2018) Prosecution – junior alone – 3 handed alleged international firearms conspiracy
- R v R (2017) Defence – junior alone – 3 handed alleged stabbing
- R v M (2013) Prosecution – junior alone – 3 handed allegation of shooting at police in an inter – gang dispute – Media coverage. (Note: the appeal against conviction of Adebola Alimi was subsequently allowed)

Fraud and money laundering

- R v T (2022) Prosecution – leading junior – 3 handed allegation of complex fraud (£ multiple millions)
- R v G (2020-21) Defence – leading junior – 5 handed allegation of fraud (£ multiple millions)
- R v J (2018) Defence – junior alone – 6 handed allegation of fraud and money laundering (2 trials)
- R v A (2017) Prosecution – leading junior – 2 handed allegation of fraud and money laundering
- R v S (2016) Prosecution – leading junior – 2 handed allegation of controlling prostitution / money laundering – media Coverage
- R v Q (2015) Prosecution – leading junior – 6 handed allegation of accident fraud and money laundering

Drugs conspiracies

- R v Z (2022) Defence – leading junior – 27 handed allegation of conspiracy to produce cannabis, representing the 1st defendant in the 1st trial.
- R v M (2017) Prosecution – junior alone – 4 handed allegation of conspiracy to supply kilos of cocaine
- R v A (2017) Prosecution – junior alone – 4 handed allegation of conspiracy to supply kilos of cocaine
- R v X (2017) Prosecution – pre charge advice in 7 handed international pharmaceuticals case

Cases involving prosecution of public servants / professional persons

- R v N (2021) Prosecution – junior alone – allegation of sexual abuse by vicar of three year old child – [Media Coverage](#)
- R v T (2021) Prosecution – junior alone – allegation of rape against a serving police officer
- R v R (2016) Defence – junior alone – allegation of drink driving with complex defence – accused was a serving Operation Trident detective
- R v W (2016) Prosecution – junior alone – allegation of fraud (defendant was a practising solicitor) – [Media Coverage](#)
- R v C (2015) Prosecution – junior alone – allegation of breach of restraining order – defendant was a practising barrister and former judicial office holder – [Media Coverage](#)
- R v B (2014) Prosecution – junior alone – allegation of arson – defendant was a practising solicitor

Court of Appeal experience – conviction appeals

- R v S (2022) – advising the CPS on the merits of a Part 10 CJA 2003 “double jeopardy” application
- R v P (2021-2022) Respondent – junior alone – ongoing
- R v J (2019) Applicant – junior alone – pro bono renewed leave for appeal against conviction, co-defending with Mark Heywood QC
- R v A (2014) Respondent – junior alone – appeal against conviction
- R v Coley and others [2013] EWCA Crim 223 Respondent – conjoined appeals against conviction – led by John Price QC – [Click here to view the decision](#)
- R v H [2010] EWCA Crim 219 Respondent – junior alone – appeal against conviction – involved the cross-examination in the CACD of a fresh evidence witness
