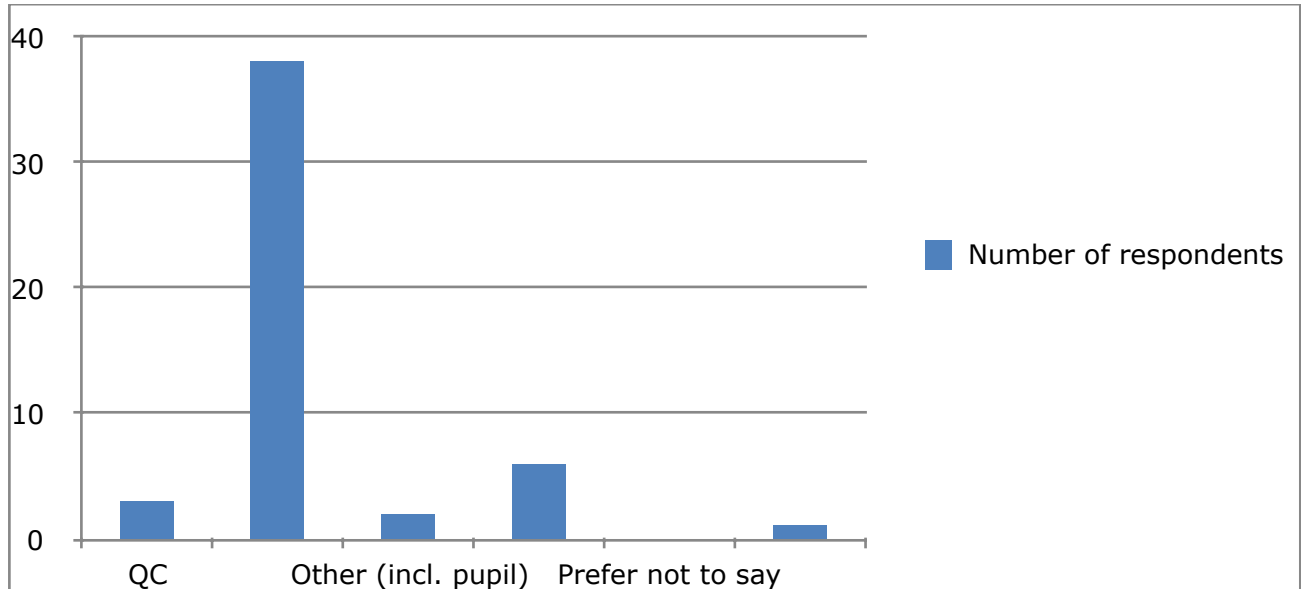


Diversity Data Statistics for 2 Harcourt Buildings

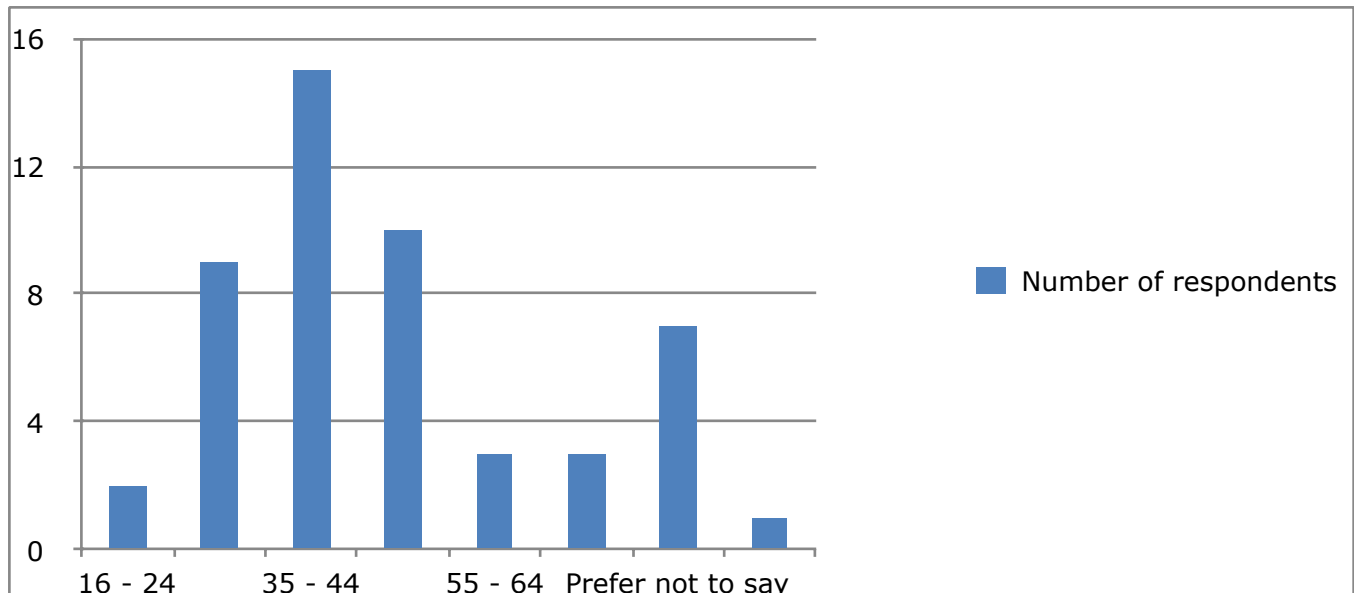

Due to the numbers of certain groups (QCs, pupils and staff) being below 10, the results have been collated and published together to any risk of identification of individuals.

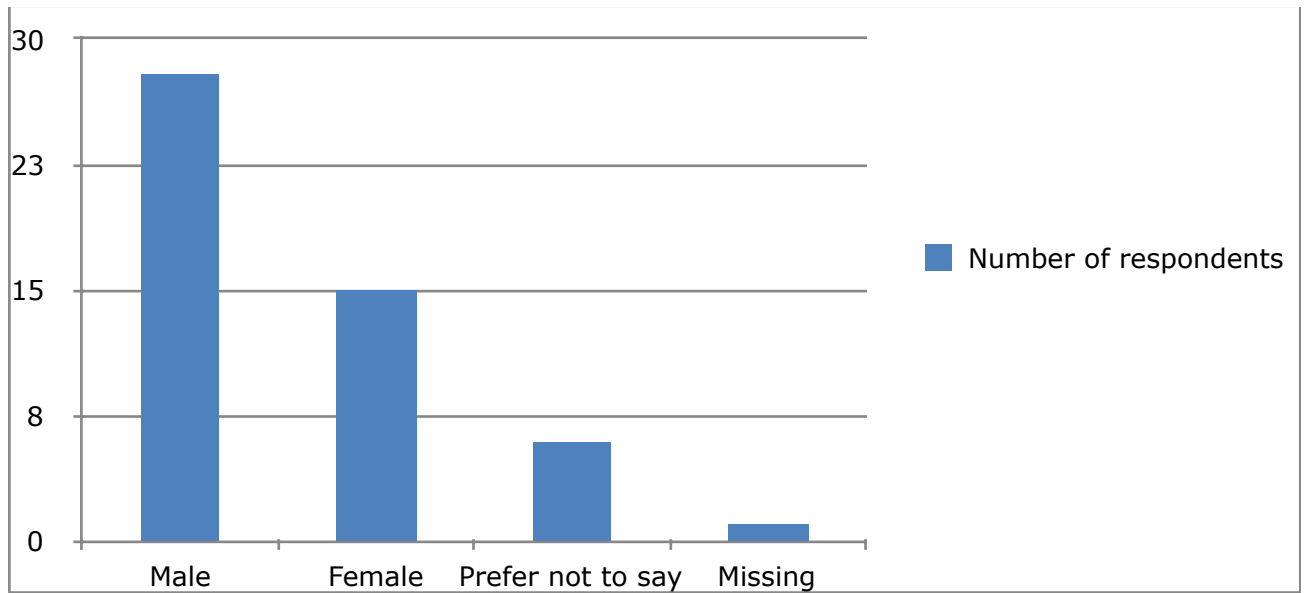
Role in Chambers



Age

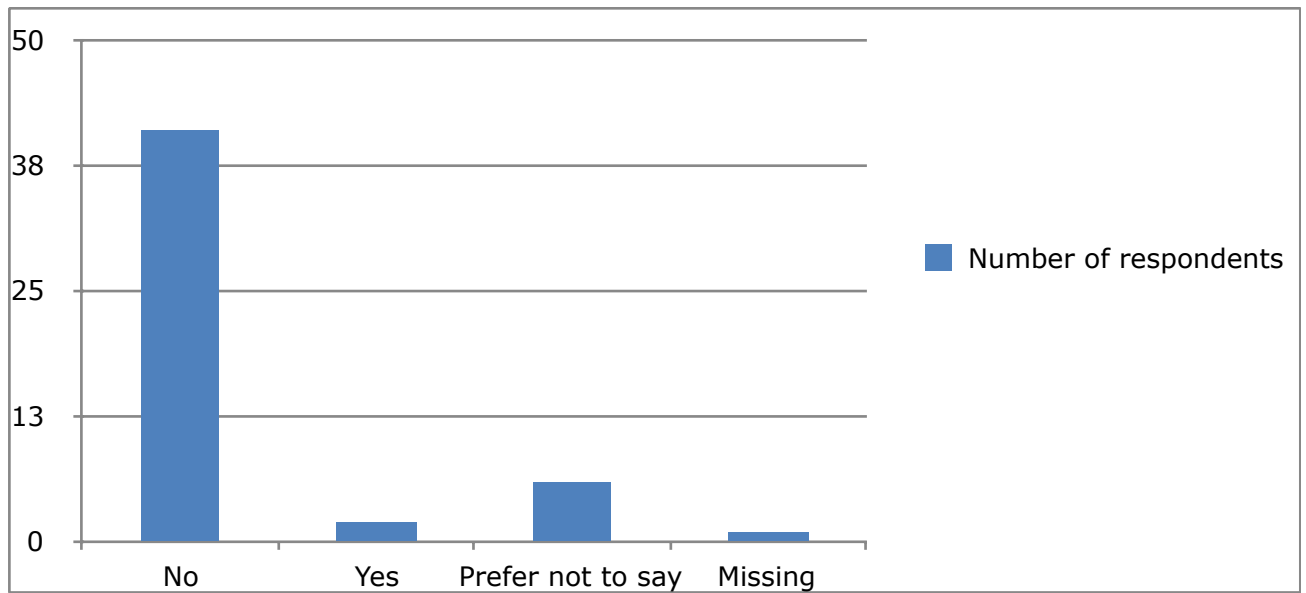


Gender

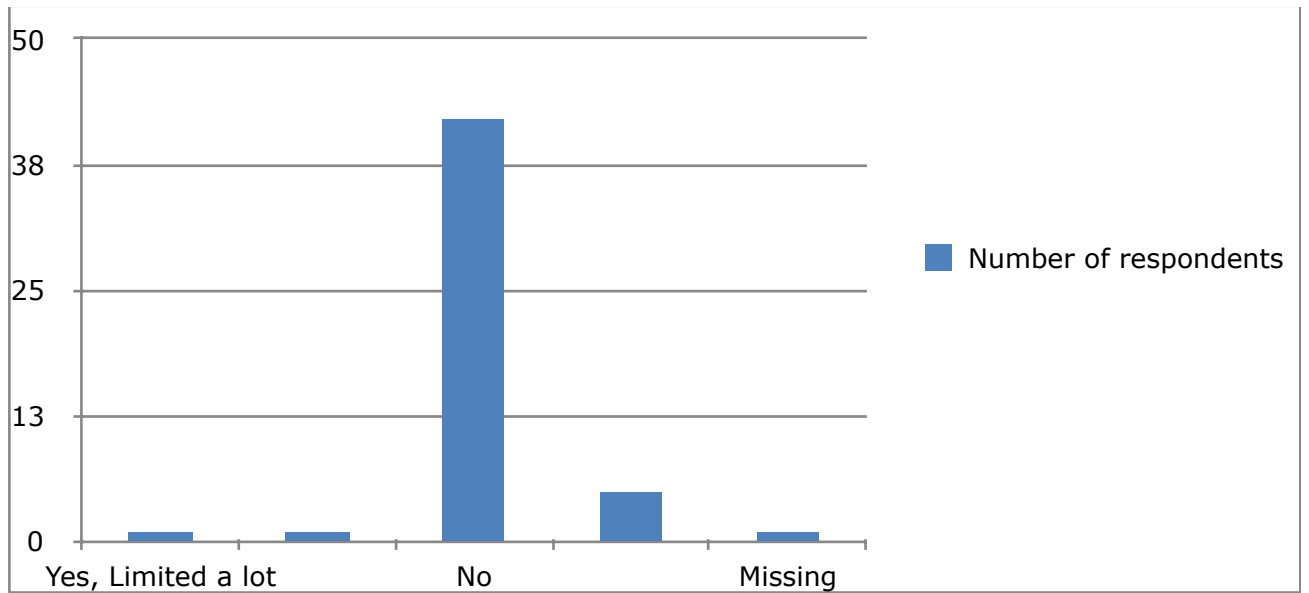


Disability

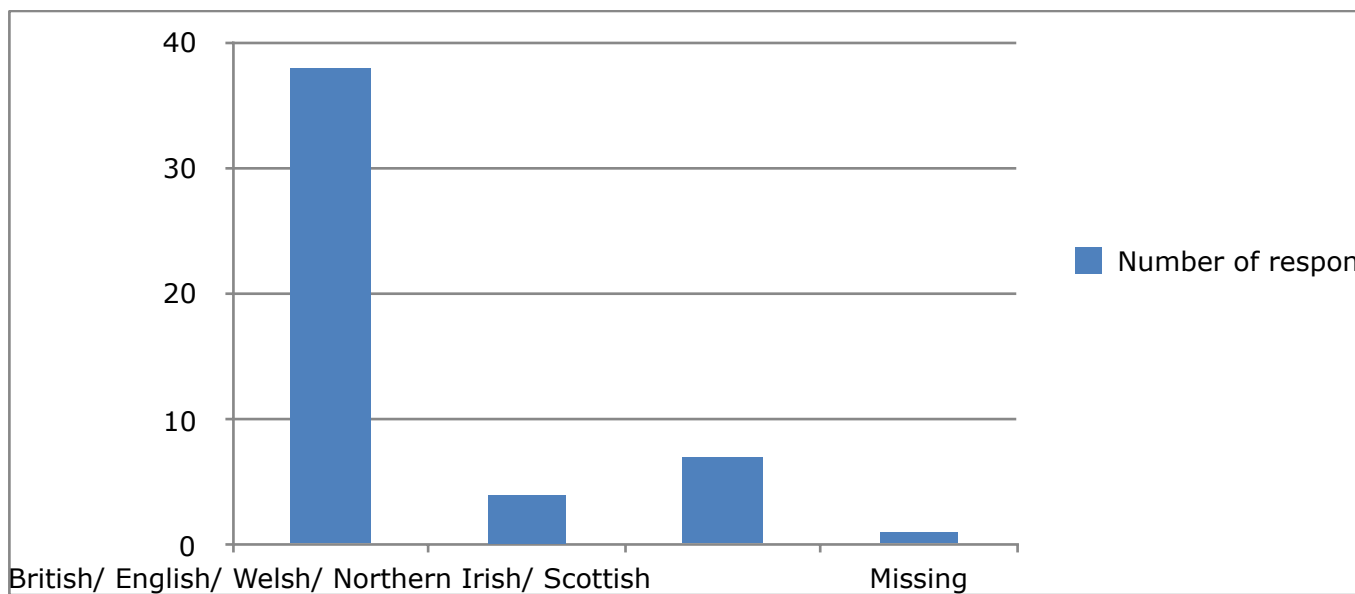
(a) Do you consider yourself to have a disability according to the definition in the Equality Act 2010?



(b) Are your day-to-day activities limited because of a health problem or disability which has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months?

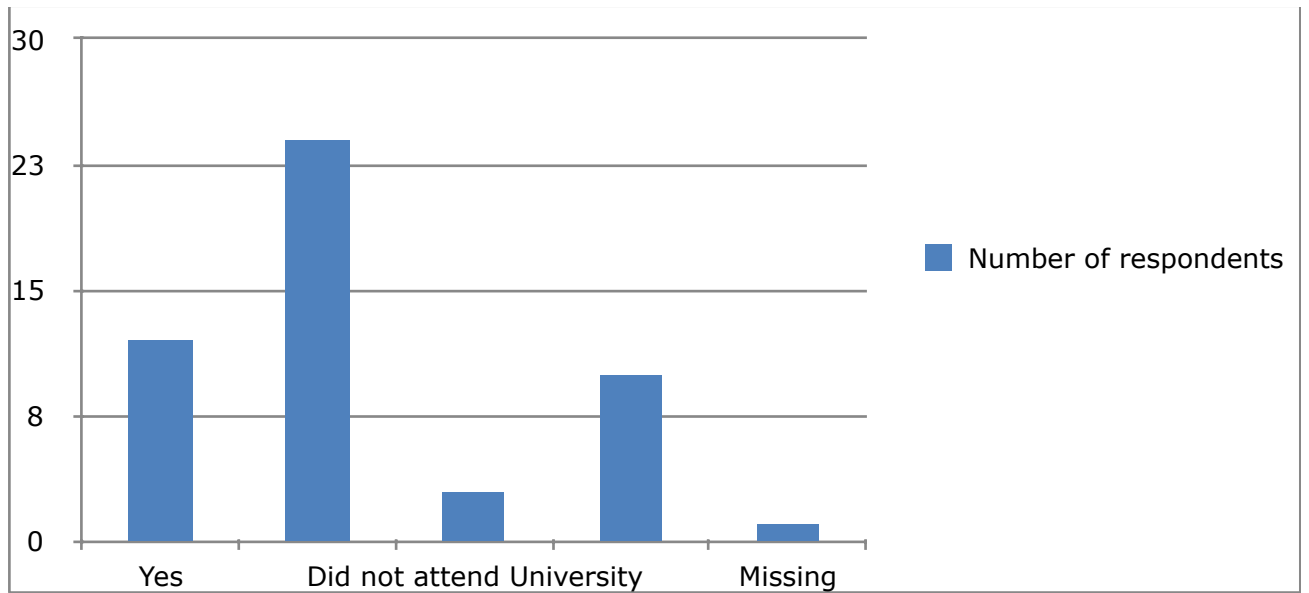


Ethnicity

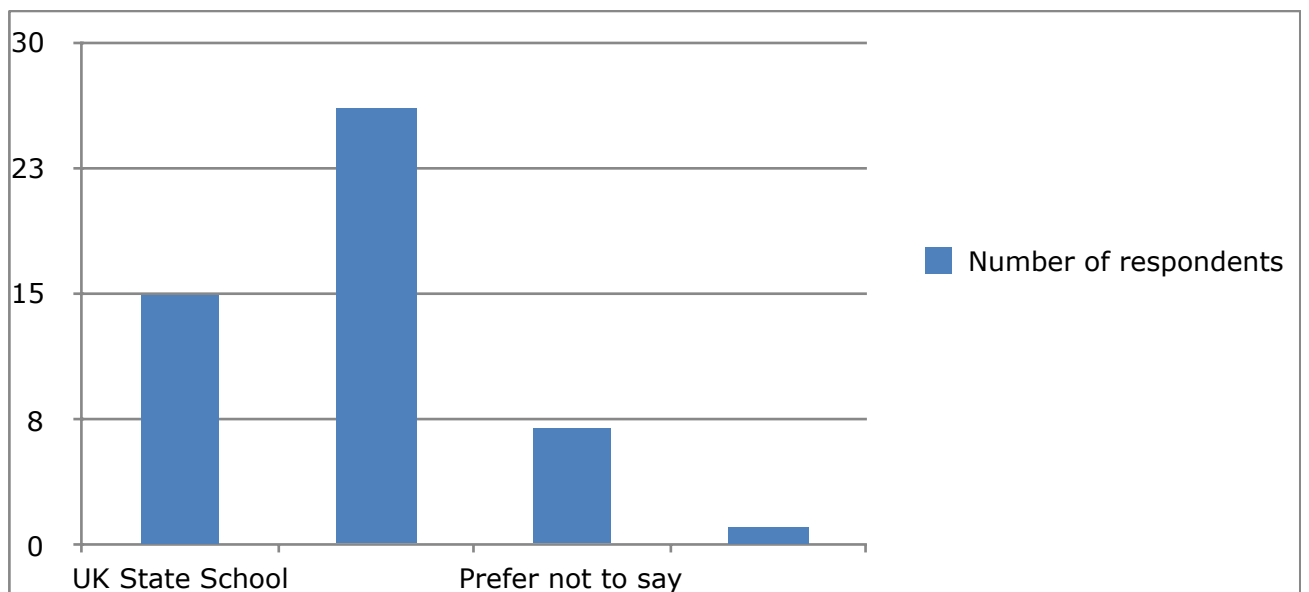


Socio-economic background

(a) If you went to University (to study a BA, BSc course or higher), were you part of the first generation of your family to do so?

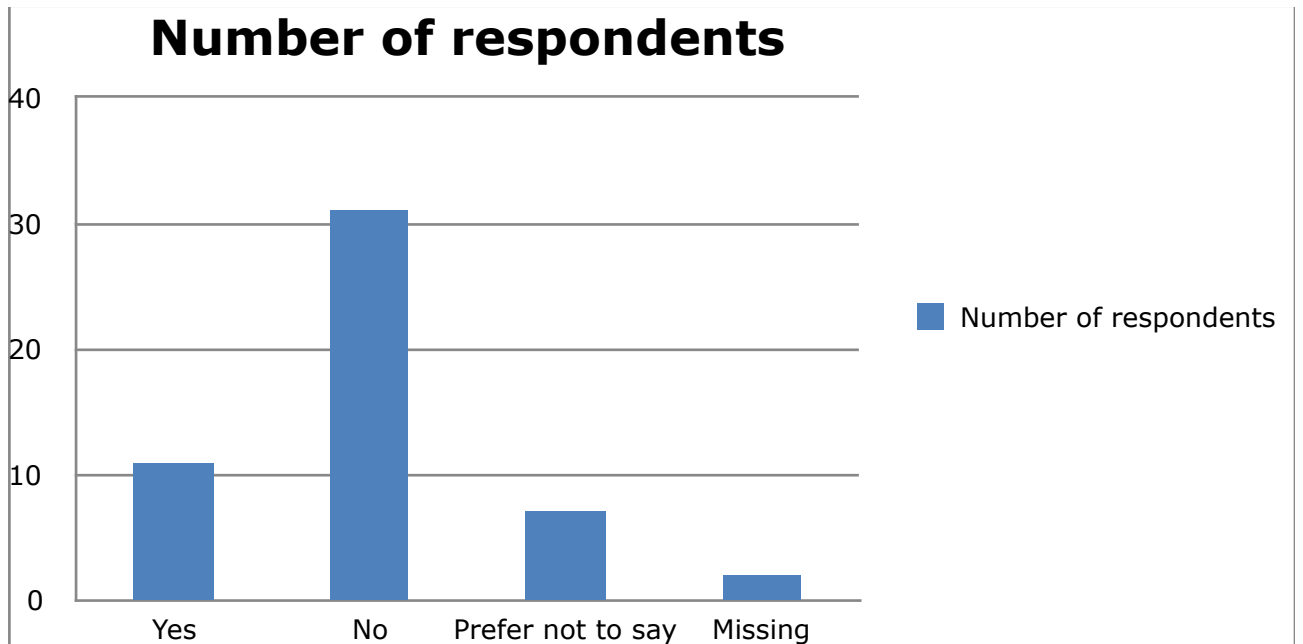


(b) Did you mainly attend a state or fee paying school between the ages 11 - 18?
